

## Jazz FM singer fuses pop music with the big band sound at London concert

Building on the success of his Jazz FM-featured EP, singer/songwriter Angus Murray will premiere his debut album at a public concert in London on Thursday 22nd November.

Angus - who has performed at The Royal Festival Hall and on Channel 4 - will be entertaining the audience with seven original scores from his album, 'Now I Know Why', as well as new arrangements of 'I Wanna Be Like You' and 'Steppin' Out'. Angus says, "The concert is an opportunity for me to express my own music but I couldn't resist the chance to include some of my favourite songs."

Both the album and concert are an all-London affair. "I recorded the album at the Metropolis Studios in Chiswick; the Fazioli grand piano that I played was the same one that Freddie Mercury used on one of his last albums." Angus chose Red Lion Square in Central London over more traditional jazz venues "...because I want to welcome newcomers to swing in a non-intimidating atmosphere." Jazz has never been so accessible.
